

Instructions
Declaration of Trade Name
Partnership Act
Form 201

The Declaration of Trade Name must contain the following information:

Item 1:

- Type of Business
- City, Town, Village where the business is located
- Trade / Business Name under which the Declarant carries on or intends to carry on business
- Date on which the use of the business name commenced

The Declarant must sign the declaration, state their occupation and indicate the date the declaration was signed.

The form must be printed or typed clearly.

Note: Filing a Declaration of Trade Name is required mainly to provide proof that the name is in use by a particular business. Filing of the declaration does not give any right of ownership of the name.

To assist you in making an informed decision on the proposed name, an Alberta Search Report (NUANS) should be obtained and assessed before you file this Declaration.

Please print two copies of the Declaration of Trade Name form and submit.
